General Information

In-person camps

- Built by Me offers 2 sessions: Morning from 9 am to 12 pm and Afternoon from 1 pm to 4 pm.
- For Campers who are enrolled in both sessions: lunch and recess is from 12 pm to 1 pm (will be outdoors, weather permitting).
- There will be a 15-minute snack break during the morning and afternoon sessions.
- Campers must bring snacks and lunch (nut-free) and a water bottle.

Drop-off and pick-up are 10-minutes before and after the session scheduled times.

- Afternoon Session:

Cancellation/Refund Policy

In-person and online camps

- Before June 21, 2021, a partial refund will be issued: 90% of the registration fee.
- No refunds will be issued after June 21, 2021. Campers can be transferred to another 2021 Summer Camp in-person or online or get a credit to use in future Built by Me programs.
- Built by Me may cancel any program due to low enrollment 2 weeks prior to the start of the camp. A full refund will be issued if no substitute program is available for the camper.
- Campers are expected to attend all sessions during their registered camps. Instructors are not required to make up lessons resulting from campers' cancellations.
- There will be no refunds or credits for no-shows, sick days, or partial sessions attended.







COVID 19 Policy

We will conduct daily health checks (e.g., temperature screening and/or symptom checking) of staff and campers, as possible, and in accordance with any applicable privacy laws and regulations. No camper will be allowed to enter the camp if the temperature is over 100.4 °F.

We will require consistent and correct use of well-fitting face masks with proper filtration by all campers, staff, and visitors.

We will run small size classes and the campers will stay in cohorts (small groups) with dedicated staff and remain with the same group throughout the program.

We will establish camp policies and use strategies to promote physical distance:

- at least 3 feet between all campers within a cohort
- at least 6 feet between cohorts
- at least 6 feet while eating and drinking: outdoors or in a well-ventilated area, with their cohort
- at least 6 feet between campers and staff
- at least 6 feet between staff

We will increase the circulation of outdoor air as much as possible (e.g., opening windows and doors when it is safe to do so). We use air purifiers with true-HEPA H13, ionizer, and UV sanitizer.

We will minimize the sharing of materials. In the case the campers need to share materials or equipment, we will limit the use to one group (cohort) of campers at a time, and clean between use.

We will sanitize and clean all the materials and equipment after each session.
